CLEANING AFTER USE

- Wear disposable gloves to clean and disinfect if desired.
- Clean surfaces using soap and water, then use disinfectant.
- Cleaning with soap and water reduces number of germs, dirt and impurities on the surface. Disinfecting kills germs on surfaces.
- Clean high touch surfaces including tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, toilets, faucets, sinks, etc.
- Hand sanitizer should be provided in public high-touch places, such as check-in systems and families should be encouraged to sanitize before/after use.



HARD SURFACES

- Take precautions such as wearing gloves and making sure you have good ventilation when disinfecting spaces.
- Use an EPA-registered household disinfectant or diluted household bleach solution if appropriate for the surface. Alcohol solutions with at least 70% alcohol may also be used.
- Keep surfaces wet for a period of time (see product label)
- Avoid mixing chemical products.
- Label diluted cleaning solutions.
- Making a diluted household bleach solution:
 - 1/3 cup of unexpired household bleach per gallon of room temperature water OR
 - 4 teaspoons of unexpired household bleach per quart of room temperature water
 - Bleach solution will be effective for disinfection up to 24 hours.



SOFT SURFACES

- Clean soft surfaces using soap and water or with cleaners appropriate for use on these surfaces.
- If possible, launder items according to the manufacturer's instructions using the warmest recommended water setting. Dry items completely. (e.g., towels, blankets, clothes)
- If laundering is not possible, disinfect with an EPA-registered household disinfectant recommended for the soft surfaces. (e.g., carpets, rugs, drapes)
- When handling contaminated towels, blankets or laundry, wear disposable gloves, don't shake out, and clean/disinfect containers or baskets holding contaminated items.
