

Acts 9:1-9

What did Paul see on the road to Damascus?

(A bright light)

Whose voice did Paul hear? (Jesus)

WEEK 2

Jesus sends Ananias to help Paul regain his sight.

Acts 9:10-31

How did Ananias help Paul? (He helped him see again.)

Who wanted to be Paul's friend forever? (Jesus)

WEEK 3

Jesus teaches Peter to love everyone, so Peter tells Cornelius about Jesus. Then Cornelius brings more people to hear about Jesus too.

Acts 10

Who did Jesus teach Peter to love? (Everyone)

Who did Cornelius bring to hear the good news about Jesus? (His friends and family)

WEEK 4

The Lord sends an angel to lead Peter out of jail, where he joins his friends who are praying.

Acts 12:1-19

What did Peter's friends do when they heard he was in jail? (They prayed.)

Who woke Peter up and led him out of jail? (An angel)
